

## Summer 2017 Intern Hours Report (July 10<sup>th</sup> – August 25<sup>th</sup>)

### Total Hours Worked: 251

#### Towerman's Watch Pathway & Map: 79 Hours

- Create a new map for the Towerman's Watch Pathway that includes the new Old Fire Tower Loop as well as adding general information on the points of interest along the pathway.
- Trimming the new Old Fire Tower Loop.

#### Dog Lake Flooding Dam Removal: 50 Hours

- Assist in laying crane mats to get to the dam site.
- Remove debris from culvert so the water level stays below a certain level.
- Help grade the new banks of the stream bed.

#### Inspiration Point Plant Assessment: 39 Hours

- Determine health of the plants that were planted by Huron Pines.
- Create a report summarizing their health.

#### Invasive Species Bio Blitz: 30 Hours

- Spray for Eurasian Phragmites.
- Monitor section of Black River (Tin Shanty Bridge to Blue Lakes Road) for Wild Parsnip and Eurasian Phragmites.
- Pull Purple Loosestrife along roadsides and Osmun Lake.

#### Traffic Monitoring: 25 hours

- Record and report traffic data from the 8 monitoring stations.

#### Erosion Control at Lost & Section 4 Lakes: 20 Hours

- Place new signs at sinkhole lakes that outline the fishing regulations and erosion control projects.
- Place plant debris across un-allowed pathways that increase erosion of the hillsides surrounding the sinkhole lakes.

#### Group Timber Sale: 8 Hours

- Timber marking for thinning
